



SOMERVILLE HOUSE SCHOOL TEAMS CHESS TOURNAMENT

Open to all students from Prep to Year 12

Venue: VPAC – Somerville House
Graham Street, South Brisbane

Parking: Gate 6 – Graham Street

Cost: \$30 per student

Entries close 5.00pm Thursday 12 February. Players who arrive on the day without registering will be turned away. Students will be supervised by arbiters on the day. Parents and spectators are allowed to attend, but cannot enter the playing area.

Times:

Registration times will depend on the division

Open Division: 9.15am to 9.45am registration

Novice Division: 9.45am to 10.15am registration

Beginner Division: 10.45am to 11.15am registration

Prize Ceremony: 3.00pm to 3:15pm

Divisions and Prizes:

Team:

Students will play in teams of four. They will be paired individually, their scores will be added together at the end for team prizes. All students must be members of the same school (No composite teams).

- ◆ Novice – Under 550
- ◆ Open – All other teams

Players rated under 550 can choose to move up to the Open Division if they choose to.

Individuals and teams with fewer than four players can enter the Novice Division. They may be at a disadvantage for team prizes, but will still be eligible for individual prizes

Medal for the top three scoring teams in each division

Medals for the top three individual players in each division

Individual:

The **Beginner Division** is open to all unrated players in Year 2 or below. Medals awarded to top three players. Players that place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in a Somerville Beginner Division will be ineligible to play in the Beginner Division again in future Somerville tournaments.
